Dear Parents/Guardians,

In May and June of last year, Grade 6 students throughout the province wrote Provincial Achievement Tests in science and social studies. Results from these tests provide Alberta Education, school administrators, teachers, parents/guardians, students and the public with information about what students know and can do in relation to provincial standards at the end of Grade 6.

Provincial Achievement Tests are based on what students have been learning throughout the school year, they are marked by teachers before they are returned to Alberta Education in June.

School staff share preliminary results with parents after the June PAT administration. Individual Student Profiles (ISPs) are now available to schools for sharing with parents. School staff then share the ISPs with parents or parents can access results directly using [myPass](#). A record of the ISP will be retained electronically in the student record. This profile is prepared by Alberta Education after the marking and scoring of tests has been completed and the final scores are calculated; it will present your child's performance on each test in relation to provincial standards.
