

#### Who is A.E. Cross?





- Born in 1861 in Montreal, Quebec
- Moved to Alberta in 1884 to be a rancher – A7 Ranche near Nanton
- In 1891, he established the first brewery in what was then called the Northwest Territories (Calgary Brewing and Malting Company)
- Founding member of the Ranchman's club
- Became MLA of East Calgary in 1898
- In 1912 Mr. Cross along with Patrick Burns, George Lane and Archie McLean (The Big Four) financed the first Calgary Stampede
- Cross House in Inglewood is now Rouge restaurant






