STAFFING INFORMATION

A.E. Cross School finds itself in a position of student growth. Our anticipated enrollment for 2023-2024 is considerably beyond where we projected ourselves back in the spring. This will allow us to hire another teaching position to A.E. Cross for the upcoming school year.

We have created a new Grade 9 homeroom, that will have Ms. Shumay as its homeroom teacher, and, on Friday following our staff meeting, administration and classroom teachers redistributed Grade 9 students looking to provide the greatest amount of equity possible to student learning. As a results of this, homerooms, Physical Education and option classes may have changed.

Great attempts were made in an attempt to keep changes to Grade 7 and 8 student schedules to a minimum. LUNCHTIME EXPECTATIONS

Lunchtime at A.E. Cross School runs from 12:07 PM to 12:48 PM each Monday to Thursday. The structure of the lunch hour works as follows:

12:07 PM – 12:25 PM – Students are welcome to eat lunch within the school on the main floor. The hallways, cafeteria and courtyard are available for student use during this time. Please note that there is currently no food service available to students at lunchtime. On days where the weather cooperates, students are also welcome to eat outside on school property.

12:25 PM – 12:48 PM – Students will be asked to go outside during this time period. It will be important that students get appropriate clothing from their lockers right at the end of the morning classes as the upper level of the school will be closed beginning at 12:10 PM.

WITH PARENTAL PERMISSION, students are able to leave campus for lunch time. To minimize the number of students visiting our community neighbours, different grade groups can leave campus on specified days.
