# **LUNCHTIME EXPECTATIONS**

Lunchtime at A.E. Cross School runs from 12:07 PM to 12:48 PM each Monday to Thursday. The structure of the lunch hour works as follows:

**12:07 PM – 12:25 PM** – Students are welcome to eat lunch within the school on the main floor. The hallways, cafeteria and courtyard are available for student use during this time. Please note that there is currently no food service available to students at lunchtime. On days where the weather cooperates, students are also welcome to eat outside on school property.

**12:25 PM – 12:48 PM** – Students will be asked to go outside during this time period. It will be important that students get appropriate clothing from their lockers right at the end of the morning classes as the upper level of the school will be closed beginning at 12:10 PM. It is really important that students come prepared for the weather as they will be outside during this time unless they are part of a supervised activity within the school.

**WITH PARENTAL PERMISSION,** students are able to leave campus for lunch time. To minimize the number of students visiting our community neighbours, different grade groups can leave campus on specified days.

- Tuesdays Grade 7 students
- Wednesdays Grade 8 students
- Thursdays Grade 9 students

Should students leave campus, it is an expectation that they are respectful to our community neighbours as they are representatives of A.E. Cross School. We have had reports from community members that some of our students are littering.

- Students should not loiter at the businesses and they should buy their lunch and return to school property
- Should students be abusing their off-campus privileges by causing disruptions in the community or are consistently late upon return to school after lunch, privileges to leave at lunch may be taken away
- Back alleys and private yards are off-limits to students
- PLEASE NOTE A.E. CROSS SCHOOL DOES NOT PROVIDE SUPERVISION TO STUDENTS THAT ARE OFF CAMPUS AT LUNCHTIME.
- Students will not leave campus on Fridays during nutrition break (11:33 AM 11:48 AM) so please ensure that they come to school with a snack.
- A quick reminder to families that students are not able to bring drinks back into that
  do not have screw-top lids on them. This includes drinks such as: slurpees, coffees
  with plastic lids, and bubble teas. Students will be asked to throw these beverages
  out upon entering the school.

#### PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

Parents/Guardians will be able to book conferences beginning on Thursday March 14, at 4:00PM. The conference bookings tool will register you to meet with 1 teacher at a time. This means that you will have to make multiple bookings if you desire to meet with more than 1 of your child's teachers, or to talk about different courses. We value the role that your child plays in their learning, and strongly encourage all students to attend conferences with their parent/guardian.

#### Format:

**Thursday March 21, 5:00-8:00PM**, all conferences will be **in-person** at A. E. Cross School **Friday March 22, 9:00AM-2:00PM**, all conferences will be **online** via Microsoft Teams and a link will be emailed directly to you after you book a time slot. Each conference meeting will be 10 minutes in length.

Please refer to this website, <u>MyCBE - School Conferences</u>, for instructions on how to book a conference through your MyCBE account. Should you have any difficulties or questions, please phone the main office and school staff can assist you. If you will require language interpreter services, please let your child's teacher know ahead of time so that they can request an interpreter to attend.

The conference booking tool will be closed on Tuesday March 19 at 9:00PM. It is important to ensure that you book your conferences prior to then.

#### SKI AND SNOWBOARD SCHOOL

Student Ski trip is scheduled for March 20. Students should arrive at school as usual and will attend their period 1 class. Students who bring their own ski or snowboard can leave it in the fitness center when they arrive at school. Please ensure students bring a long sleeve (hoody, etc.) as well as mitts. Students must have long sleeves worn when on snow, as well as mitts or gloves. If they do not have a long sleeve they will need to keep their jackets on and may get quite warm. #### STUDENT ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

When a student is late and has missed the attendance taking, and the teacher marked them absent, the student needs to stop by the office, so we can correct that.

If the student doesn't hear their name called, when they are in class at the time attendance is taken, they should bring that to the teacher's attention.

Teachers have no access to change attendance once it has been submitted. Hence, the reason for them to visit the office.

The attendance message via Messenger goes out twice a day – after Block 3, and after block 6. If the "A" was marked in the AM, but has not been acknowledged/corrected (by student, or parent), the same message will go out in the afternoon as well, so you will likely get two messages for the same absence (even if it is just late, but has not been corrected)

#### **VOLUNTEERING AT A.E. CROSS**

There will be activities done at A.E. Cross that require parent volunteers.

Starting on **Friday**, **Feb. 9**, parents and guardians can register to volunteer online in the SchoolEngage tab of their MyCBE account. Members of the community without a child in the system can also create a SchoolEngage account.

Once volunteers have created an account they can request and receive their volunteer letter required to obtain their police security clearance. Schools will continue to follow the process for generating letters.

There are no changes, at this time, to the ePIC application and payment process, currently outlined on the CBE Volunteer InSite page and managed by Calgary Police Service.

Once volunteers have their police information check and vulnerable sector clearance document (PIC VS), it can be uploaded and shared directly with the school through the SchoolEngage account.
